The Board would like to share some of the projects we have been working on for 2021, some planned, some not, but needed.

New Lighting at Travis Road Entrance

New landscape lighting will be installed with all new LED lighting. Morgantown Road Entrance lighting was replaced last winter. Hopefully next year we will be able to update/replace Stones Crossing Road Entrance lighting.

Redress areas around ponds where eroded

Primary Grounds will be in to repair lawn areas around the ponds that eroded. The drainage culverts will also be cleaned up and stone added. Please try to stay off of the stone and refrain from throwing stones into the ponds.

Spring Flowers

Spring flowers have been planted at the entrances and the round-a-bout enhancing all the areas. Hope everyone enjoys!

Central Fountain

Since the rehab of the central fountain, we have had several groups of children climbing into the planting areas and onto the bottom bowl of the fountain. Please advise your children to NOT participate in this type of behavior. It would be very costly to replace parts of the new fountain.

We have sent letters out in response to concerns

we have received regarding the temporary basketball goals, mailbox repairs, pergolas, gazebos etc. We hope to have the cooperation of all homeowners in upholding the KG Covenants and Restrictions.

- Certified letters have been sent to those owners who have temporary BB goals in their drives requiring the goals to be stored in the garage when not in use. Your neighbors sincerely appreciate your cooperation.
- Letters have been sent to homeowners requesting landscaping be replaced. C&R states the minimum must be maintained, including keeping beds clear of weeds and lawns maintained.
